LITURGY OF THE WORD

First Reading: Acts 2: 1-11

When the time for Pentecost was fulfilled, they were all in one place together. And suddenly there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind, and it filled the entire house in which they were. Then there appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted and came to rest on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim. Now there were devout Jews from every nation under heaven staying in Jerusalem. At this sound, they gathered in a large crowd, but they were confused because each one heard them speaking in his own language. They were astounded, and in amazement they asked, "Are not all these people who are speaking Galileans? Then how does each of us hear them in his native language? We are Parthians, Medes, and Elamites, inhabitants of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the districts of Libya near Cyrene, as well as travelers from Rome, both Jews and converts to Judaism, Cretans and Arabs, yet we hear them speaking in our own tongues of the mighty acts of God."

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 12: 3b-7, 12-13

Brothers and sisters: No one can say, "Jesus is Lord," except by the Holy Spirit. To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit. As a body is one though it has many parts, and all the parts of the body, though many, are one body, so also Christ. For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, slaves or free persons, and we were all given to drink of one Spirit.

what was happening

but underlying all this
was fear of being tortured
of being murdered
like jesus had been

i knew we needed
something to help us
continue his work
we seemed to be

reflecting that
this was happening
within me
the flowing of jesus' spirit

this fire burning down
deeper and deeper within
something was happening
with this fire that
i could not move

conflict with him
i felt he had been
too narrow
he has acted as if

i looked around the circle
all being enveloped
in flames

*i give you my spirit

i was feeling the desire

inside each of us
he knew how difficult
it is to get along
why did we get
into conflicts?

*i will give you my spirit

within your smallness*

i felt at that moment

i felt my heart

like fire burning
