MEDITATION: I WILL BE WITH YOU ALWAYS

(through the eyes of benjamin)

closing my eyes fear of being almost shaken from my chair something powerful was happening in this space

i was expecting to see jesus in our midst the noise of rain falling pounding was blocked out there was a wild storm like the ones we would have on the lake in capernaum

feeling now
this thunder
was within me
it was just at this moment
i felt fire pouring into me
feeling i could not breathe
now the thunder
was speaking
receive the holy spirit

i could hear jesus' voice i give you my spirit

fire burning within me what was happening in this room?

i looked around me the flames of fire burning a thunderous sound i knew this is what we had been waiting for

we had been working hard we were passionate about our work but underlying all this was fear of being tortured of being murdered like jesus had been

i knew we needed something to help us continue his work we seemed to be falling apart as a group

amidst a loud thunderous crash a voice was saying i give you my spirit

reflecting that this was happening within me the flowing of jesus' spirit

this fire burning down deeper and deeper within something was happening with this fire that i could not move

fire was burning deep down with this moment so intense

i walked over across the room now nathan was looking at me

all during these weeks i have been in conflict with him i felt he had been too narrow he has acted as if his was the only way to do things sometimes his ideas were so wrong and he would push so hard that we would be forced to follow his ideas

thunder fire presence and a circle of community

why are relationships so difficult? why do we find it so hard to get along? why are we so competitive and let resentment into our hearts? i was now feeling this fire burning away pettiness i was making room from my small self for something great

the thunder was getting louder and the fire was burning brighter

i looked around the circle all being enveloped in flames

i give you my spirit to build bridges not tear them down

inside of me
i was feeling the desire
to be closer to nathan
not to have so many walls
between us

jesus more than anyone knew what was going on inside each of us he knew how difficult it is to get along why did we get into conflicts?

i will give you my spirit to be with you to give you strength not to remain within your smallness

i felt at that moment my heart was being stretched i felt my heart was being formed to be like jesus' heart i could feel how much my heart had become like fire burning

a joy was filling this space jesus' spirit was making me different that i need not be caught in trivial concerns a deep desire within was whispering jesus i would like my heart to be like yours fire deep down deeper and deeper within me

i was so moved with jesus' spirit that this power moved me to go over to nathan and reconcile with him

realizing how i once wanted to build a bridge with him

there was a profound joy spread across nathan's face feeling jesus' spirit

this fire was giving us the strength to see what joined us together that jesus is the center and when this is not the case the bridge collapses

with this spirit our circle was closer than ever

my heart had been stretched that i could be different towards those with whom i had problems

i was overflowing with love and i could tell all of us around the circle were feeling this

this spirit helps us be more than we are
